How to Show Form on a Botanical Subject

The class will be structured for the participant with limited or no experience in botanical art and for the aspiring artist wishing to prepare for the five-day master class with Anne-Marie Evans.

The key components to be covered will include the ability to show form on a botanical subject. By developing keen observational skills and drawing techniques, the subject matter will show form and will have a natural appearance when produced in graphite or water color.

Margaret Best is a renowned and highly respected artist and teacher of botanical art. Her work has been exhibited in prominent exhibitions not only in Canada, but in the USA and England where she was awarded the prestigious Royal Horticultural Society Grenfell medal. Margaret regularly teaches private groups and individual students which include the American Society of Botanical Artists, Filoli - San Francisco, Calgary Zoo and Botanical Gardens and many other areas including locally, at the Huntington Library, Museum and Gardens, San Marino. She is a member of the American Society of Botanical Artists and other respected art organizations.
