SALIDA, COLORADO A Watercolorist's Best Kept Secret

This four-day **plein-air watercolor workshop** is an "all-levels" course. The goal is to provide participants with the tools and skills to capture "Watercolor Snapshots" in a spectacular Colorado location.

The Course:

Leon and Marjorie provide step-by-step instruction in painting with transparent watercolors. Each day builds upon the previous day's successes. Starting with the fundamentals, students learn how to find and develop "thumbnail" sketches into cohesive compositions. Daily demos visually instruct students about: the importance of "values" in a landscape, the simplified color palette and color mixing, how to build a complete painting with a common-sense succession of color layering.

Both instructors offer a wonderfully personal approach to teaching and conveying their knowledge. One-on-one critiques provide personal attention while in the field, helping painters gain a comfort level with the tasks at hand. Daily group instruction, group critiques, and evening presentations present multiple opportunities to observe and learn from the group.
