The workshop: This NEW 4-day plein air watercolor workshop is a perfect follow-up to the Plein-Air Watercolor Primer workshop and previous Leggitt/Loughridge Postcards From...workshops. Starting at a more advanced level, students delve into challenging aspects of CVCT. From value and temperature sketches to capturing light throughout the day, students learn how to use "schematics" for problem-solving, to improve time management, and to develop larger and more complex watercolors. Each day presents enticing landscape exercises, composition opportunities, personal instruction and quidance.

The location: Nestled on 40 gorgeous sweeping acres and surrounded by the picturesque Rocky Mountains, the Aspen Meadows Resort is home to the Aspen Institute. The resort, designed by Herbert Bayer in the Bauhaus style, boasts a classic and creative history dating back to 1949. Each spacious room with floor-to-ceiling windows brings the inspiring, mountainous surroundings inside while the contemporary and simple furnishings decorate the rooms.
